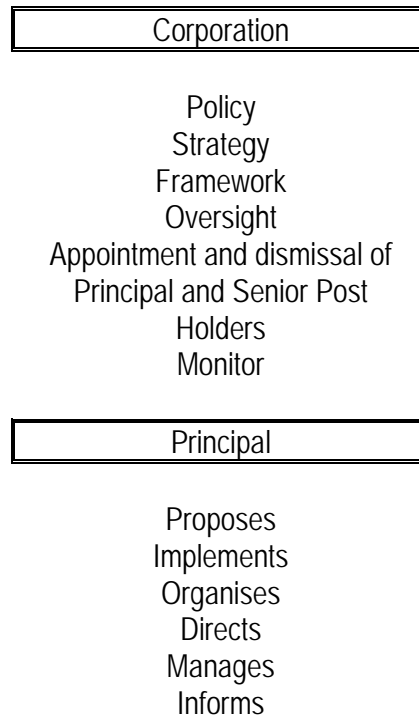


# THE ROLE OF THE CORPORATION AND MEASURES OF EFFECTIVENESS

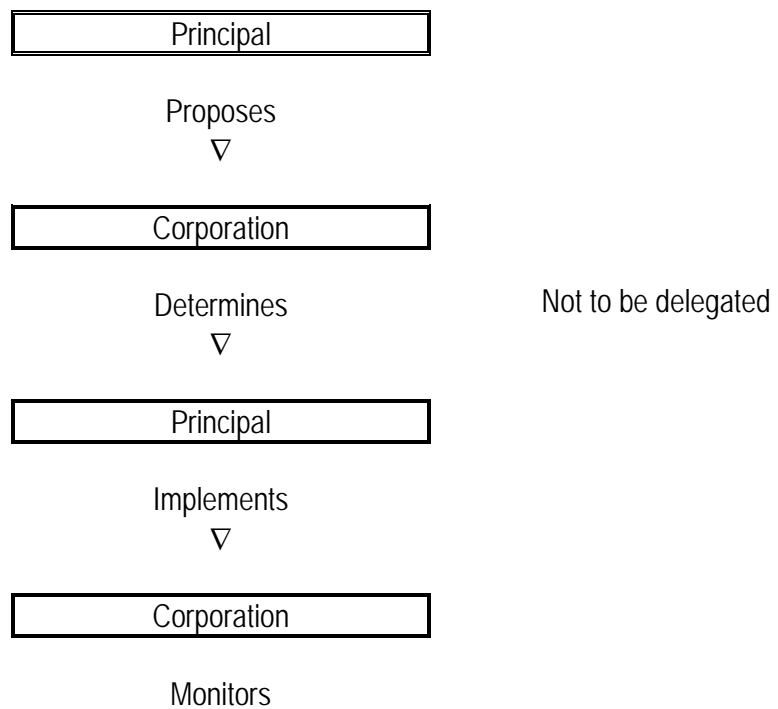
## Role of the Corporation
