What will I study?

This is an exciting course which will allow you to explore a wide range of art, design, and media skills. You'll explore new skills such as animation, drawing and painting, photography, 3D skills, filmmaking, and games design.

Many assignments are based on real life scenarios, and you'll learn about professional artists, animators and filmmakers. You'll grow in confidence as the course progresses and towards the end of the year, you'll develop your own work in your own chosen creative pathway.

What can I do next?

Level 2 Creative arts is an excellent entry level qualification that allows learners to develop a variety of skills including, illustration, photography, post production image editing using Adobe creative suite, video production, video editing using Adobe creative suite, animation, gif creation and exploring a variety of other media.

Level 2 creative media is an excellent opportunity for learners to reach their chosen paths at level 3. Progressing to Level 3 games design, level 3 art and level 3 social media content courses as well as a variety of A levels should they choose.

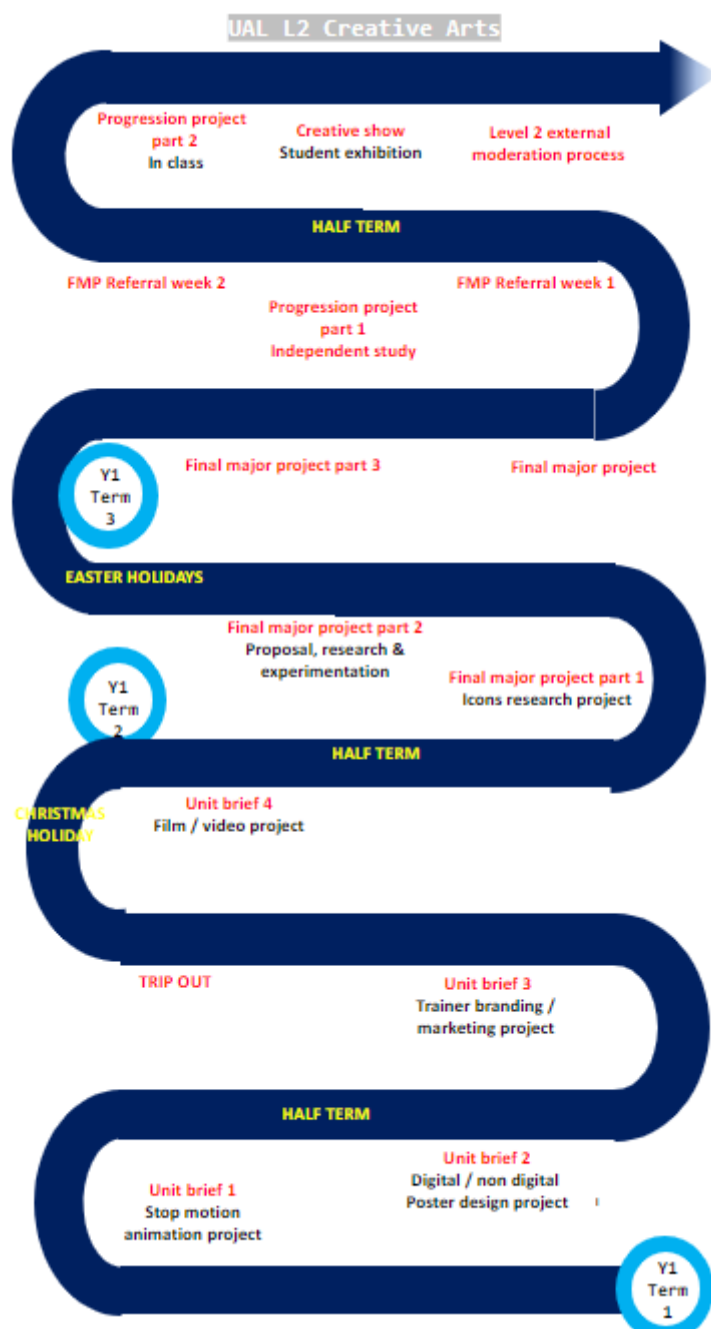
What additional opportunities will I have on my course?
